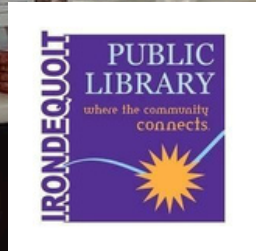




# IRONDEQUOIT PUBLIC LIBRARY
