The Erie Canal Museum offers many interactive exhibits and is set up for a self-guided experience. However, they often have docents available to engage with visitors around the Museum. Docents are typically available Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from 10am-12pm. They offer educational lectures, workshops, and social events including their holiday gingerbread gallery. New renovations for accessibility!

In the summer, they offer a series of Guided Walking Tours. During these tours they use an audio amplification system.
